### Abstract

The government of the Republic of Kazakhstan has developed a program for restoration and sanitation of the lakes Schtschutsche, Borovoje and Karasu, which are located in the National Park Borovoje, in the northern part of Kazakhstan. The water quality of all these lakes is poor due to human impacts. The main reasons for eutrophication of the mentioned water bodies are discharge of wastewater to the lakes, water supply through water abstraction of the lakes and the growing tourism in this area. In line with the project, an analysis of the existing condition through local survey, water and sludge monitoring and using actual satellite data is required. Analysis of the satellite data is necessary in order to specify the chlorophyll content in the water. With the help of additional local measurements, the chlorophyll content can precisely be adjusted, so that monitoring of the water quality through satellite application can be made possible in future. The second part of the project is preparation of the tender documents and supervision for the purpose of lake restoration, including removal of the contaminated sludge from the river bed.
