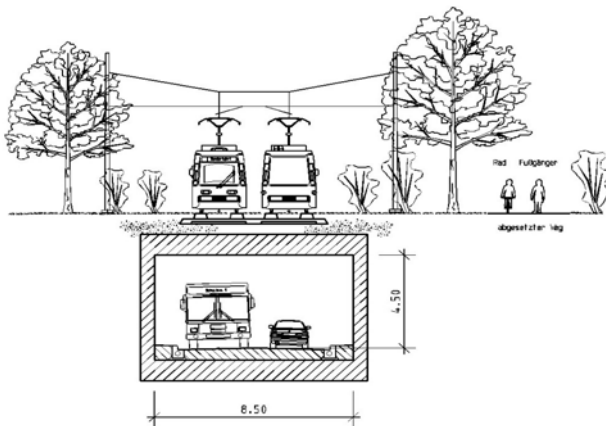

Abstract

English Garden, an outstanding recreation area in Munich, borders southwards on Schwabing in the West and on Bogenhausen in the East. Besides a bus connection for public transport through the English Garden, there have so far been only 3 transport connections between these districts.

In line with development of a traffic concept, a further direct connection, especially for the small traffic between the two districts, will be investigated in consideration of the existing traffic system. The concept will include a tunnel for individual transport and a new tram connection for public transfer. Both track systems shall be constructed upon an already existing road.
