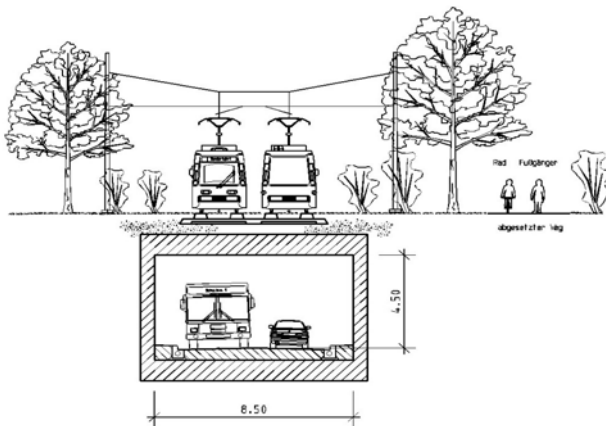

Abstract

English Garden, an outstanding recreation area in Munich, borders southwards on Schwabing in the West and on Bogenhausen in the East. Besides a bus connection for public transport through the English Garden, only 3 further transport connections existed between these districts.

In line with development of a traffic concept, a further direct connection, especially for the small traffic between the two districts, was considered in view of the existing traffic system. The concept included a tunnel for individual transport and a new tram connection for public transfer. Both track lines were constructed upon an existing road.
